We will each be writing a historical fiction short story set at any time in American history from Pre-Columbus to 1900. Short stories are generally 500-800 words (3 to 4 typed pages), have few characters (perhaps only one), cover a short period of time, and have only one setting. Good historical fiction will meet the following criteria:
